QUESTION 1: I am currently on video 111 of the Wes Penre videos, and so far you have said that Enki wants to enlighten us and Marduk wants to enslave us. That we have a choice to either go to "Heaven" with Enki or "Hell" with Marduk (which I assume is the Singularity). I understand that there is conflict between these two factions. Marduk's faction and Enki's faction. I'm assuming that either choice we make, to either join Enki or Marduk would mean to go to the tunnel of light right?

What will happen to those who choose to join Enki in "Heaven"? Will they go to the Singularity? What are his plans for his followers?

ANSWER: There are no absolute answers to your questions, but if I collect from my memory what I have learned and base my answer on that, I would say it's a mixed bag. Enki/Yaldabaoth will probably let some souls who die now "ascend" through his ascension process if they are ripe enough for that. This means a certain portion of souls will not reincarnate but get assigned other

tasks. Those, who would have been destined to be recycled, with or without the Singularity, will be recycled into the Singularity.

The question is whether those who over time have ascended through the Heavens will eventually be sent back to Orion. That is Yaldabaoth's obligation toward Orion in an old agreement, but will he really do it? Who knows?

Although it seems to be the case that Marduk is more of a player on the Singularity stage than Yaldabaoth, it's not black and white. Marduk is an "extension" of Yaldabaoth in that he is a trait or an attribute of his "father." Yaldabaoth and Marduk are both Archons, and Marduk was created by his father as a "thoughtform," you could say, which was so strong that it took on its own life, just like the rest of the Archons. They all represent different aspects of Yaldabaoth's traits. So, Marduk can't do much more than just work with what he has, which is limited and very destructive. Yaldabaoth has both positive and negative traits, but we was not born in the Spiritual Realm and lacks True Spirit. Therefore, he lives in Ignorance/Darkness, and he can't comprehend True Spirit. He knows it exists, but it's incomprehensible. So, he becomes the God who represents both Good and Evil in his own universe, i.e., the Kenoma/Matrix. If he thinks he's Almighty here, he also *must* be everything; good *and* evil; but because of ignorance, he is self-serving at the core, and his own interests and benefits are measured above everything else. His Pride comes from his delusion that he is Omnipresent, although at the same time, he knows there is something above him that he doesn't understand.

QUESTION 2: Can a sickness or ailment of any type prevent someone from gaining Gnosis and living more in Spirit?

ANSWER: It depends on the ailment or sickness. Someone, whose mind is "gone," can obviously not absorb information and therefore not learn what they need to learn to gain Gnosis while here on Earth, unless they, through consequent incarnations, get the chance to improve their cognitive ability. Can someone gain Gnosis without the Gnostic texts? I would think it *is* possible, but it really requires that the person gains control over their mind and gets in touch with Spirit. Still, that person needs to know what to do with it. Will he exit after death, or will he be lured into the System again? He might be of the right frequency to leave, but the way I understand it, that's not enough if the person doesn't know what is going on here on Earth and in the Kenoma. It's easy to be manipulated if we are not educated.

QUESTION 3: Would you mind explaining from your experience what it means to be in a romantic relationship while also being your own source of happiness and not depending upon each other to be happy?

ANSWER: The way I see it, a romantic relationship should be an enhancement to the life and customs we have when we are single. Most of us have things we like to do; we have passions, hobbies, friends, and you name it; anything that we enjoy in life. Adding a romantic relationship to that, in my opinion, should be done in order to further expand oneself together with another person with whom we share values, thoughts, spiritual path, and love with. If we feel that the relationship prevents us from doing things we like to do, it might not be beneficial. It's important to express ones needs and boundaries with each other before the relationship really takes off, so both parties know what they can expect and what they want to work on. If they both consider this being something exciting and enhancing, it's a very good start. Physical attraction—at least to some degree—should probably be present, too, because it's a part of the whole, being human. Physical attraction is not always the “looks” of the other person—it's a physical pull toward him or her that is *felt*.

The relationship that is most likely to last is one with open communication, and the willingness to be vulnerable and honest. Building trust is also crucial; it's done through communication and action. And there needs to be an agreed-upon amount of intimacy; physical intimacy of different kinds, but also emotional intimacy and willingness to build a closeness with each other.

The so-called “Interdependent relationship” is the one that will be easiest to maintain, I would think. This means that both partners will do well without each other; financially, emotionally, or otherwise, but they both want the relationship as an enhancement to their lives and because they love each other. It should preferably not be a substitute for something else, but an enhancement. Both do their best to meet each other's needs, while at the same time meet their own needs where the partner can't do it. Because people are different, we might not get all our needs met by one person, and we might not be able to meet all our partner's needs, either. And I don't imply that people should be polygamous; that, from what I have seen, only leads to problems in the long-term. Perhaps, that works for a few, but not for the majority, as I see it. But friends can also fill in on needs that can't be met by the partner or oneself.

Interdependent people tend to be of the more secure kind with less codependent attachment styles, which also makes it easier to maintain the relationship. Most people, however, have their wounds and traumas brought into their relationships, which can damage or destroy the relationship in the long-term. This is why communication is so important. Talk about these things with your partner-to-be before the relationship, and if both are willing to work on this and heal through the relationship, this can also be very beneficial and rewarding, but also tough.

Much can be said about relationships, and it would be too much to bring up here. I am certainly not an expert and I have made my own mistakes in my relationships, so this is just how I personally see it, currently.

QUESTION 4: What will be indicators to know that En.ki/Lucifer is going along to attack the Orion Empire for the final battle? To your knowledge, is the Saturn stargate functional at all?

ANSWER: From what I've concluded, the attack against Orion will not happen until we become completely integrated with the Machine Kingdom (A.I./the Singularity) and our bodies are transmuted into cyborg. If our bodies are made with nanotechnology, it means we can also travel through the Universe on a nano-level, which is exactly what the Archons want. This is also why they are so much in a hurry to complete their Work of the Ages; they need to get ready before Orion strikes. At least, that seems to be how they think. I wrote in the Wes Penre Papers that the Archons have been given an ultimatum to let all humans free, or the Archons will "pay the price."

As far as I know, the Saturn stargate between the 7th and 8th Heaven is still closed.

QUESTION 5: If you take the vaccine, at what point in changing our bodies wouldn't we be able to escape the construct?

ANSWER: At the point when you no longer care whether you're in the Singularity or leave the Matrix. So long as you still intend to leave the Matrix, there are solutions so you can do it. It's when you make a choice that you want to join the Singularity world instead that it obviously becomes critical. Then you shift your attention from leaving to staying. However, that too is a choice, and we have freewill.

I can't say for sure, but I don't think the vaccine is the only thing that will make us want to usher in the Singularity and keep us trapped in it. It's just another step on the way, albeit a bigger step than previous steps. We also have Musk's satellites to take into consideration. He speaks of a brain implant, whether that will actually be mandatory. It's highly plausible, though.

Their goal is to create cyborg bodies built on nanotechnology, with the human species completely adapted to the digital world, no more biological bodies. The bodies will then be "immortal" and death is no longer going to happen naturally. I still think we can die even if we're cyborgs, if we destroy the body to the extent that it becomes non-functional, and *then* we can leave the body. But there will come a point when most people get so used to that kind of existence, and not having to die, that trying to leave their bodies is not an option for them. They will be very pleased with where they are.

No one knows for sure how all this is going to pan out, target by target, so we need to step back and observe and keep ourselves up-to-date, and without getting attached. Also make sure you still have your imagination intact and that you are in charge of it (see Video 259 on Imagination). Be in control of your own mind; this is why it's so important to educate ourselves and do the healing within, to the best of our ability. Be confident about what is "you," the core soul, and

what is your subconscious mind. The subconscious mind will not go away, but you can learn how to be in charge of it if you can distinguish between that and your conscious and Divine mind. You can catch yourself before you are automatically and subconsciously reacting to something out-of-control and instead make a conscious choice that benefits you and manifest that instead.

My best advice how to avoid the Singularity is to “know thyself.” An aware soul cannot be trapped unless she allows herself to be trapped. Trust yourself! That also ties back to the question about relationships: you can’t successfully trust others if you don’t trust yourself.

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
