

Video 264: Q&A Session #78

QUESTION 1: About exiting through the grid: Some say go to the "highest aspect of yourself". Isn't the highest aspect of our soul group Sophia? Going further, isn't the very highest aspect the Monad? I think I am getting from the Gnostic Texts that your spirit will not go to a higher place than you are ready for, is that correct? As far as I know in this lifetime, I am not ready to go to "oneness" yet or merge and lose my identity. I still have things I want to do and experience

because I feel cheated by this construct of pain and suffering and trauma. I want to experience the beautiful original planet the Namlu'u were meant to or something similar with plants and animals and nature and love. What are your thoughts?

ANSWER: The bottom line is that depends on its vibration and frequency range where the soul goes after death. However, many people are anxious and worried about not making it, and I understand that. Therefore, a good thing to do, in my opinion, is to decide for yourself beforehand where you want to go and what you wish to do, using your imagination. What's your passion? What are you dreaming about that you wish you could do, and where would you rather be? If you have that clear in your mind that's the thought, focus, and intention you create when you leave the body. The "Universe" will respond and either give you that or something closest to what your vibration allows you to experience.

If the person doesn't have any idea or real goal set for themselves, I have suggested they can go to the "highest *possible* aspect of themselves," with the emphasis on *possible*. That should transfer the soul to the highest level they can experience within the range of their current vibration. All this is to help people to focus, instead of being afraid and not having any intention or thought at all, which would possibly make them subjects to recycling. The chances you are going back to Source and being absorbed by Source, so to speak, and lose your individuality, is very unlikely. We are created here to experience, and the sorting will not be done until after the Consummation of the Age (see Gnostic texts). Then, some will remain in the Greater Universe as creators, while some return to the Spiritual Realm. But not even then will you go anywhere you're not ready or willing to go. So, there is really nothing to be afraid of. It's going to be a much neater experience wherever you land than in this controlled environment.

It sounds like you already know where you want to go. I am doing deep research right now, and it will take time, but it seems to me that the so-called "original planet" still exists in certain terms, parallel to us, let's say. It's more to it than that, but just to simplify it for now. So, if you intend to go to that place, set that intention and thought when you exit, and learn to focus through meditation, for example. Daily meditation will help people being less distracted and more focused.

QUESTION 2: Was Jesus sent to Earth by En.ki or Marduk, by the Queen Divine Mother in Orion, or by the Monad/Source? Also, I have heard many stories that exist that are similar to the one of Jesus that supposedly happened before he was here; virgin birth, dying and rising from the dead 3 days later, etc. I am also aware that in the Nag Hammadi Jesus was watching the fake Jesus being nailed to the cross and did not really die and rise 3 days later. Was Jesus what they say he was or was he sent by beings with bad intentions for us?

ANSWER: The entire Jesus story/stories are just as complicated to wrap our heads around as the rest of our so-called “history.” I think it’s profound to distinguish between HIS-story and HER-story. Our HIS-story is the story about our Patrix (Kenoma) and HER-story is the time before the current Patrix was created. What we have learned in school, history books, and through academics in general, is HIS-story, which is 98% false (my estimate). Yes, it’s that bad. It’s nothing like anybody thinks it is. The more I look into this, the deeper the rabbit hole goes. But I don’t care if it’s endless (which it seems to be), I will follow it as long and as far as I can.

You are absolutely right that there have been many “Jesuses,” so to speak. We can even go back to Mithra and Krishna, to mention two of them. Then we have the Gnostic texts that seem to talk about two different Jesuses—one being of the Divine (Sophia and her masculine counterpart—Christ manifesting in a physical human body, souled by Sabaoth/Ninurta/Prince En.lil). So, what makes the Gnostic texts truer than the stories about Mithra and Krishna? Objectively speaking—nothing. But it’s not Jesus in the flesh that is important, or Krishna, or Mithra—it’s the message that was handed to us. How does a certain message affect us? It’s for each one to experience. It’s irrelevant if a physical Jesus walked in sandals here on Earth or not; it’s the spiritual message and the Gnosis one can receive that’s important. In a realm of duality, it shouldn’t come as a shock that Jesus is portrayed as both of the Good and the Evil—if one exists, the other does, as well. And, of course, the Gnostic texts have been interpreted by humans, who have their own biases, so we really have to feel things out and decide for ourselves what rings true. What stays in your heart and what feels repelling?

QUESTION 3: When out of the Grid, if someone even for a moment thinks back about Earth, wouldn't they instantly be back, since the Universe is thought-responsive, and everything is instantaneous there? For example, now I'm 45. I ventured into all these truths only about 4 years ago. I don't have a lot of time to be alive here. So, let's pretend I have about 5 more years left. Within this time frame, how can I become completely thoughtless, so I can bypass this horrible predicament? How will I know the exact level of awareness I need, and on which frequency level, when I’m taking my last breath? I don't want to be captured again!

ANSWER: Like you’re saying, the Universe is thought responsive, and it will take a moment or two before we, as souls with no physical body, will get used to it. From what I have heard from people who have had Out of Body Experiences, they bounce around a bit before they get the hang of it, and then it is fine. This is why I am stressing thought, focus, and intention. That will take you out of the Grid. Then, if you accidentally think yourself back into the Patrix, just repeat the original thought, focus, and intention. Then you will get the hang of it. It’s easier than you think. It’s like when you’re burning yourself on the stove as a child. You might do it once—sometimes even twice—but you learn quickly.

QUESTION 4: Did humans exist side by side with the dinosaurs and the Namlu'u? Also, do you think some supposed wiped-out species ended up changing their frequencies to exist in Agartha (Inner Earth)?

ANSWER: At one point, the Namlu'u and the dinosaurs, among other animals and beings from our "past," coexisted. The current human species, *Homo sapiens sapiens*, is a later creation, and a subspecies to the Namlu'u, who were much taller. Most of them were killed off in the so-called War of the Titans that I wrote about in the Wes Penre Papers (WPP), and which is also conveyed in Greek mythology. But I do believe there are still Namlu'u left, although not in our Patrix/Kenoma, which we know as our planet and the other bodies in our solar system. Did they end up underground? Perhaps they did. Or is Agartha something else than what people think it is? Again, I'm doing research on all this right now, and we will see what comes out of that...

QUESTION 5: The WPP mention creating all sorts of things as creator Gods after we exit the Grid, but the WPP also explain how Sophia created, and it was using genetic engineering and seeding plants and what not from other constructs onto the planet, the living library. She apparently worked with other beings as well. If I am recalling correctly, she didn't just use her thoughts. There was electricity or energy used and it wasn't instantaneous. Can you elaborate or correct me on this, so I have a better understanding?

ANSWER: Yes, you do remember correctly. There have been, and are different versions of Earth or Gaia, and the current one we live on is very young in comparison. The Queen, a.k.a. Sophia, is also manifested in matter. In the Spiritual- and New Age communities, she is usually called Gaia. Many people look at Sophia as someone who is humanlike, similar to a fairy queen, perhaps, but Sophia is an Aeon, and she is nothing like us humans. We tend to humanize her because we need some kind of reference point. And if her Spirit and soul are manifested in matter in form of Gaia, it's not as a humanlike being, of course. The *Enûma Eliš*, the Babylonian creation story, talks about Sophia as Tiamat, and she is described as a planet—not a queen-like being. Then we can continue down the rabbit hole—what is a planet? But that's for later. In the *Enûma Eliš*, where it says Tiamat screamed in agony, it was the planet that suffered, not a humanlike being. Poets sometimes use the phrase, "Mother Earth is crying..." That's close.

In the WPP, I talked about Orion technology, which was used to create life in the material universe. In the physical universe, everything is about vibration and electromagnetism. If you look at a flower, it is shaped like a symbol or has a geometric form. This is because it has a certain vibration, and it looks like it does because of its fixed vibration. This is how it is with everything, including you—everything has its unique vibration, and that's why things have the shapes they have. And this is also the reason why we, as souls, who are bioelectricity, go wherever our vibrations fit outside the Patrix.

QUESTION 6: What influence does suicide have on us leaving the Grid?

ANSWER: Again, it has to do with vibration. Regardless of whether you live in the Patrix or somewhere else in the physical universe where you have a body, this body is a part of you (Spirit, soul, body), and part of your overall vibration. You don't want to damage your soul, so intentionally killing your body will lower your overall vibrations, which limits your choices in the afterlife. That is the short answer, but I think it's the most important reason not to do it.

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
