

# Video 289: Q&A Session #91

**QUESTION 1:** When we exit the grid and enter Orion, we'll retrieve fragments of ourselves and become whole again. This is when we would become our higher selves and see things from a lot more perspectives (I hope I'm saying this idea correctly). So, when this happens, would things we cared about during our experience on earth become meaningless, including promises, as a result of the change, or would we still care about them (although not to the extent that we would want to return)?




**ANSWER:** When we exit, we keep the personality we have at the exit point because that's our soul/mind personality we've gained through our life experiences as a soul/mind/Spirit. Then, we get additional awareness upon that because our physical bodies dull our perceptions, and we become limited to a more material, 3D thinking, in general. Even people who die and do not exit will gain some extra awareness when they depart from their bodies.

Because we continue being us, we might see the importance in working on ourselves before we exit. The higher our understanding of ourselves, who we are, where we came from, where we are, where we're heading, and why we are here is, and the more we have worked on our inner fears, the better off we will be as creators in the Orion environment.



Genuine human souls are empathetic and compassionate, so I would suggest we still care about those who are left behind here. But we will also see things from a higher perspective than we do

now in our 3D incarnation. We will better understand the immortality of the Spiritually connected souls that are still within the Construct, and we will better understand that time is not a big issue. The main concern would be if the Controllers of this world would completely succeed in their Singularity Agenda, attack Orion, using human souls as shields, and succeed with that. I still doubt that they will, but I have no way of knowing.



When it comes to promises we've made before death, it depends on what kind of promises. Because we are we even after death but with expanded awareness, and we promise something to people that we never kept, we might have regrets about that if it makes life harder for them. My suggestion is to try to keep our promises as well as we can and not make too many promises too far into the future if other people's decisions are depending on them. There is always a chance we can't keep them because we might die before it happens. But in my opinion, it's just a matter of common sense and judgment. We are not perfect, and if we did what we could, I doubt we will have many regrets afterward. It should also be mentioned that many people who have had Near Death Experiences (NDEs) are in total peace with everything and don't seem to feel any regrets or having much attention on their previous incarnation.




**QUESTION 2:** I had an NDE on October 14, 2017, which has led me to do much researching and self-searching. What was the huge Crystal-like "tree" that I experienced? It was dark all around and reminded me of a giant filming studio but made to look and feel like space. I tried to move forward but I felt like I had a backpack on, which was firmly connected to something behind me.

I never experienced a tunnel, other beings, or a bright comforting light.

I remember being in the most indescribable peace. Nothing mattered, then I heard, "stay with me", far away in the distance and I returned to my body and immediately vomited.

Ever since then my whole life has changed, though I get a little disturbed that my NDE was so different from the norm. Do you have any insights to where I went?



**ANSWER:** Regarding your particular experience with the "tree," it's impossible to say exactly what that was because it was your personal experience, but the astral is very thought-responsive, and it's also much easier to create there with our minds. I'm not suggesting that you were thinking about a crystal tree at that moment (unless you were), but we also encounter other souls' creations in the astral when we go out there, whether during an OBE or an NDE. So, the image could be anything...



Not everybody sees the tunnel and the light, so that is nothing to worry about, in my opinion—I look at it as a good thing because I don't want to go there. Each person's experience is different,

and it's also a question of how close to death you were compared to perhaps someone else who was closer and actually entered the tunnel before they returned to their body. Because the astral is thought-responsive, and if you want to exit through the Construct after death, I would suggest maybe consider following the guidelines I have set up here on my blog under the heading, "[Exiting the Grid.](#)" It's about soul vibration and frequency. What and how much are you willing to experience? How much fear prevents you from experiencing certain things, etc.? It's important we work on our fears and emotional wounds as much as we can during our lifetime. It's actually here, in the physical world that the learning lessons take place.



**QUESTION 3:** Who is SAMAEL, who also appears in some gnostic texts (Nag Hammadi)? Is he Mars or Mercury? In the Jewish Encyclopedia, "Satan" is also called Samael. In the "Semiphoras of King Solomon", if they are true, there are two "Lords of Host":

1. Venus called Adonai Sabaoth (Angel Haniel)
2. Mercury called Elohim Sabaoth (Archangel Michael)

Who is really SAMAEL, which is Satan - the "Accuser" and the "Enemy of Israel" in the Jewish Encyclopedia? I do not fully trust these configurations of the Sephirot & Qliphoth Trees of Kabbalah because I have seen many different configurations. SAMAEL is Mercury or Mars. In King Solomon's Semiphoras:

- Mars has the throne/seat of judgment and he is the only seraphim or the seraphim chief.
- Mercury / Michael is the leader of the Archangels.



**ANSWER:** I think it has to do with which school of learning we follow. I have come to my conclusions by going where the information takes me and I have connected the dots to the best of my current ability, but it's an endless process, of course.

SAMAEL means “blind god,” and is another name/title for Yaldabaoth, the head Archon, who sees himself as the God of the Universe, according to the Gnostic texts. He was named SAMAEL by the Queen of the Stars, aka Zoë Sophia.



One could look at him as both God and Satan in this Construct we call the Matrix/Kenoma. He would be the ultimate of both (the archetype of dualism), but still self-proclaimed, not by any means the real God. Satan is a term that just means adversary, and he is the adversary to light/knowledge, because he represents darkness/ignorance—thus, he's the “blind god.” SAMAEL claims ownership of the 7 Heavens within the Matrix/Kenoma, represented by seven heavenly bodies, i.e., Saturn, Jupiter, Mars, the Sun, Venus, Mercury, and the Moon. Then there are 5 Heavens of the Underworld, according to some ancient texts, also called Hell. Two of those are Pluto and Uranus. SAMAEL considers himself being the God of all of them, but he delegates responsibilities to his Chief Archons—one for each Heaven. These Heavens are what we are supposed to ascend to or descend to, depending on our vibration, until we reach Saturn, the highest, and then we're supposed to be set free into Orion. By going through the Grid, we bypass all that and go directly into Orion instead.



Mercury and Michael are two different entities; Mercury representing Thoth and Michael being Sabaoth—both are Archons, but the latter has repented and is working with Sophia. So, as far as I have concluded, there is only one *real* Sabaoth, which is Archangel Michael, who is also synonymous with Yeshua (Jesus in the Bible and the Gnostic texts). In the Wes Penre Papers (WPP), he is Ninurta and Prince En.lil among other titles. His main Heaven (planet) is Saturn, which then was hijacked by the being with the title En.ki in the WPP and elsewhere in my writings. Before the War of the Titans, it seems like Mars is another planet/Heaven Sabaoth was in charge of before the Cosmic War—Sabaoth is also the Judge. In other ancient texts, Mars is related to Marduk, which would also be after the hijack.



**QUESTION 4:** How can I find out if I am a Namlu'u or star being?

**ANSWER:** I think there are a few things you could ask yourself: do you have genuine empathy and compassion for self and others? Can you feel true love? Are you curious about who you are and your place in the Universe? If you can answer any or all of these questions positively, you are a spirited Soul, i.e., a Namlu'u/Aryan. And the fact that you are here shows you're curious.



**QUESTION 5:** In case that I die during sleep while in a vivid dream, do you think that I realize that I am dead? The same problem I can imagine is that for example, I drink a bottle of whiskey and/or use drugs and die suddenly - would you think that one can distinguish or assess this new situation? Is the drug high or alcohol intoxication feeling also in the astral or only while in the body? The same could be asked when it comes to Alzheimer's. Is Alzheimer's only there when we are in the body, or does it hunt us also in the astral? Can I realize it fast enough to exit?

**ANSWER:** When it comes to overusing drugs and alcohol, it's not a high vibration, and it indicates that there is an underlying emotional and psychological problem, such as severe trauma earlier in life that should be addressed as soon as possible so insights can be gained, and a higher soul vibration achieved. But in general, if a person gets so intoxicated that they die, it could take a few moments for that soul to realize what happened and that they actually died. But the intoxication will not continue in the astral—drunkenness and drug effects are emanations from the body and affect the mind, not the other way around. So, when the soul disconnects from the body, the intoxication ceases.

The same thing applies to Alzheimer's or Dementia. They are experiences between body and mind, and when the body dies, the mind returns to its normal shape.



A person who is determined to leave this Construct and prepare themselves while still here on Earth will hopefully not follow anybody's advice in the astral. Even if they are disoriented at first, they will most likely "come to their senses" and set their intention to leave, without paying attention to a potentially distracting environment.

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
